2. Rules Committee

Chair: Meredith Parris (NC)

Current Charges:

1. Provide an interpretation and educate the compact states regarding the statutory requirements of a BON with respect to:
*Art III (c): Each party state shall require the following for an applicant to obtain or retain a multistate license in the home state:
6. Has submitted, in connection with an application for initial licensure or licensure by endorsement, fingerprints or other biometric data for the purpose of obtaining criminal history record information from the Federal Bureau of Investigation and the agency responsible for retaining that state's criminal records
when an applicant applies for a MSL by exam or by endorsement or as an upgrade from an existing active unencumbered single state license.*
2. Draft strategies for education/training targeted for attorneys/staff related to Art III (c) 5 which clarifies that a nurse changing PSOR needs to be eligible for a license in the new PSOR but does not necessarily need to hold an active license in the former PSOR. This provision supersedes state law which may be in conflict.
3. Conduct a comprehensive review of the NLC rules per the 3-year cycle.
4. Draft a FAQ on LPN challenge to RN NCLEX.
5. Draft a rule on the NLC annual fee.
6. Draft language for proposed rule amendment: clarification on rule 202 – query Nursys upon MSL application for license by exam; query fraud activity and discipline.
7. Draft language for proposed rule: alternative-to-discipline (ATD) participation in a remote state/implementation of speed memo to home state to convert to single-state license.
8. Amend rule 503 (Compliance and Enforcement) – reference: former policy 6.4 (NLC Non-Compliance & Enforcement)

Charges Completed:

1. Develop uniform compact rules for consideration by the Commission.
2. Develop a Regulatory FAQ to clearly define statute, rule, bylaws, policies and advisory opinions.
3. Review existing rules and recommend necessary changes to the Commission for consideration.
4. Draft a proposed rule to define full party state participation in the coordinated licensure information system to include license verification, discipline and licensure information.
5. Develop a FAQ related to a letter of reprimand and decide whether it is an encumbrance.
6. Draft model language for ATD program participation agreements.
